HISTORY

Created in 1937, The Union de Producteurs de LUGON is situated in the heart of Bordeaux region, close to Saint-Emilion and Pomerol. The winery represents 130 winegrowers who tend 800 hectares of vines. Every year, it produces the equivalent of 6 million bottles of 6 appellations especially Fronsac and Bordeaux.

WEATHER CONDITIONS

Bordeaux vineyards had never known such a terrible frozen period since 1991. At the end of April 2017, a frozen wave reached the vines, unfortunately they started to grow many days ago. Most of vines were destroyed and could not produce any grapes. Luckily, thanks to a warm and sunny weather in Summer until September, grapes in the saved vines could grow and ripe in the best way. Finally harvest production is low but the vintage 2017 has a good quality.

BLENDING AND AGEING

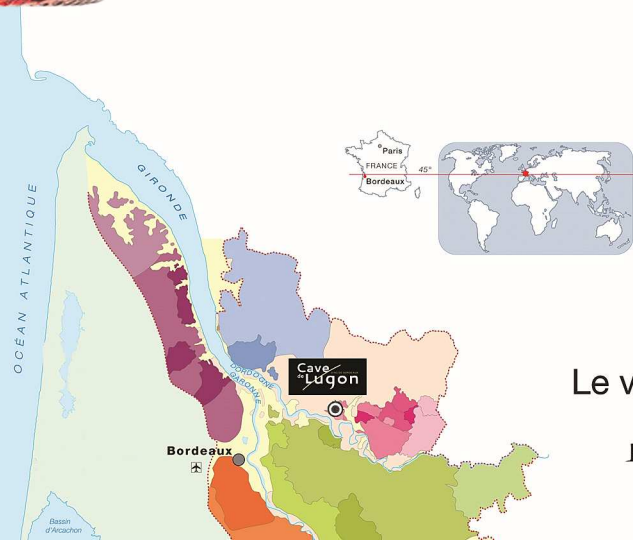
Following consultation with our oenologist, Grandes Versannes was blended in function of plot origins to achieve a balanced wine. The wine was aged in stainless steel vats.
